## **Bassenthwaite TT**

**29 April - 1 May 2023**

Bassenthwaite is justifiably one of our most popular sailing venues, and we shall be returning there over the May Day Bank Holiday weekend. This year, as well as the club fleets, we shall be sailing alongside a visiting Mirror fleet for whom it will be their Northerns.

### **Online entry**

**Entries and camping bookings must be made online by Sunday 23 April** at [Bassenthwaite Sailing Club: Home \(webcollect.org.uk\)](http://Bassenthwaite Sailing Club: Home (webcollect.org.uk)). Late entries are at the discretion of the club and at extra cost. The entry fee will be £35 per boat. Registration will be from 11.00 to 13.00 when you can collect the Sailing Instructions.

A briefing will be held at 13.30 on the first day. The Notice of Race is available on the website, and a copy is attached for convenience.

### **Accommodation**

Camping is available on the club grounds for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. It will cost £12 per unit per night for caravans and motorhomes and £9 for tents. Payment will be taken in advance online with your event entry fee. You can start arriving from 17.00 onwards on the Friday. The gate is being upgraded, and the code for it will be announced in due course. The clubhouse will be locked at 17.00 on the Monday evening, though you have until midnight to vacate the site. Dogs are permitted in the Club Grounds but must be kept on a lead and are not allowed in the Clubhouse.

Early booking is recommended, as the Lakes are a very popular destination, especially over the Bank Holiday weekend.

## **Catering and social activities**

Light catering will be available on Saturday and Sunday for breakfast and lunch. The bar will be open to provide drinks and light refreshments, plus teas and coffees during the day.

It is expected that the club will organise a barbecue one evening, (probably Saturday), but no details are available yet.

A fleet meal been organised for the Sunday evening at 7.30pm in the bar (not the fine dining restaurant!) of the Hundith Hill Hotel (Lorton Vale, near Cockermouth, Cumbria CA13 9TH, 01900 822092). The menu accompanies this invitation. **Please let Stuart know your food choices by midday Friday 21 April.**

There are several ways to approach the hotel which lies to the south of the A66. Perhaps the easiest is to turn onto the B5292 Lorton Road and then take the first left to Hundith Hill, but there are various country lanes off the A66 that are more direct if coming from the sailing club.

## **Directions**

Bassenthwaite SC is at the northern end of the lake in the village of Dubwath (postcode CA13 9YD) just off the A66 Penrith-Keswick-Cockermouth road. Turn right off the A66 on to the B5291 and immediately right again. The entrance to the club is 100m on the right.

## **Other attractions**

Why not tarry a while and spend some time enjoying the magnificent Lakeland scenery? Visit attractive towns and villages like Ambleside, Keswick and Windermere; stroll along the shores of the many lakes; or head for the hills where the walking is out of this world.
